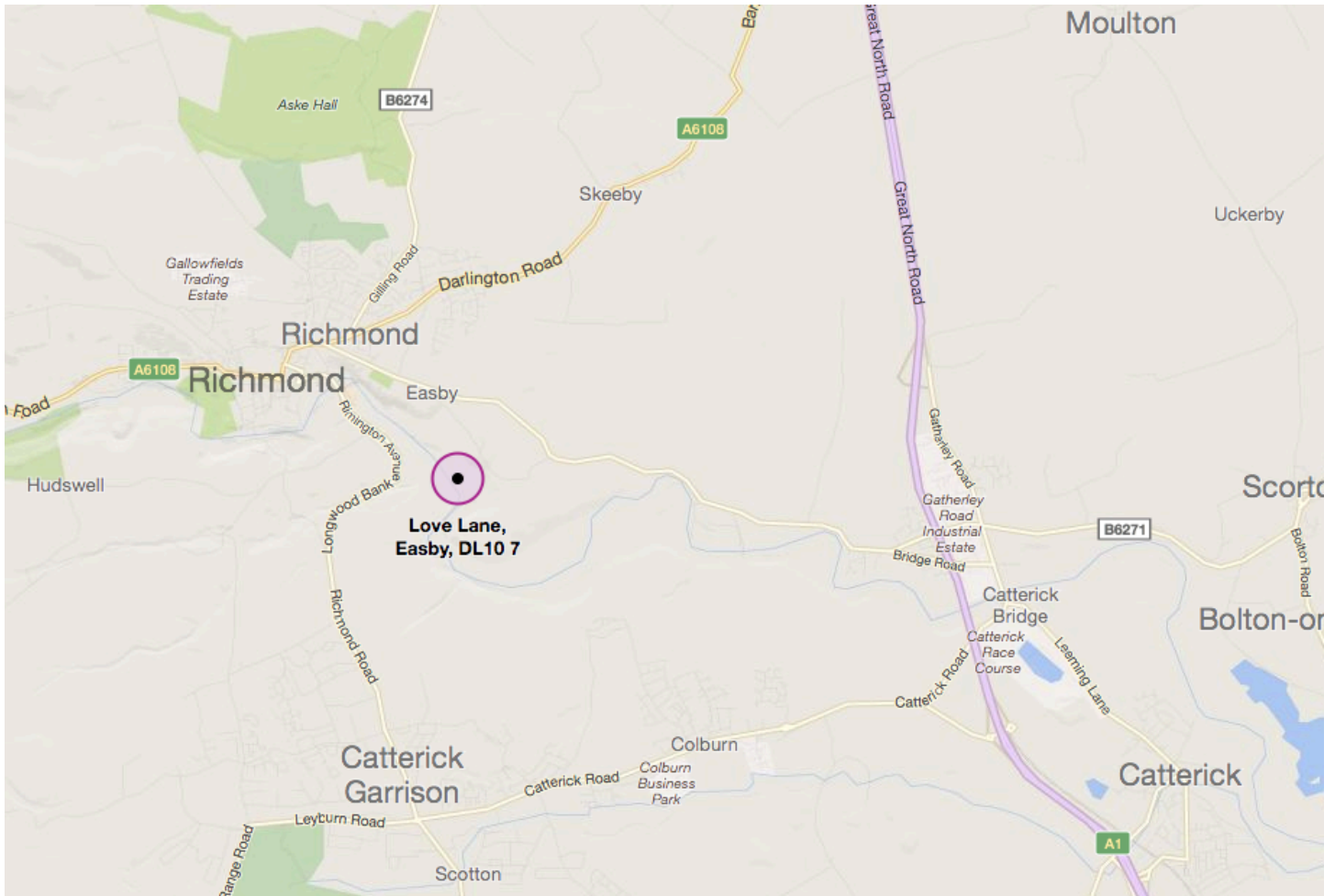

## LOCATION DIRECTIONS

<p><b>TO MEETING POINT</b></p>	<p><b>FROM THE A1:</b> Leave the A1 at Catterick and follow signs to Richmond. Follow the B6271 through the village of Brompton on Swale. Just after passing the caravan park on your left look out for a sign to Easby Abbey. On seeing the sign, turn left on the bend and follow the road to the car park at the bottom of the hill.</p> <p><b>FROM RICHMOND:</b> Take the A6108 out of Richmond following signs to the A1 South. As the road forks, turn right onto Maison Dieu. Follow this road and keep a look out for a brown sign to Easby Abbey. On seeing the sign turn right and follow the road to the car park at the bottom of the hill.</p>
